**HMS BRISTOL WEEKEND VISIT 24 – 29 AUGUST 2008**

1. H.M.S. Bristol have kindly accepted our bid for a week visit in 2008, as shown above. This visit is for a maximum of 50 cadets ( 35 m + 15 f) and for up to 13 staff, ( 8 Officer and 3 SNCO's + 2 CI). One of which must be female!. The staff allocations can be varied if demand is such.

2. This visit will require cadets and staff attending to be able to leave unit HQ's by 1100hrs on the SUNDAY, and all should return by 1800 hrs on the FRIDAY. A provisional programme is attached for information, further evening activities are planned. ( Cadets who have attended these visits previously should NOT be nominated). These programmes are subject to alteration.

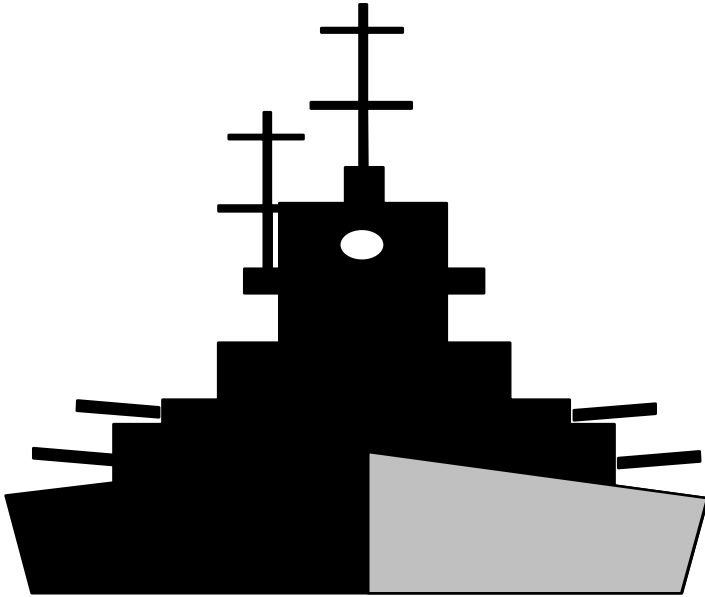

Transport will be by 5 Squadron Owned Vehicles, and there is likely to be budget reductions which will mean that the SOV's will probably not be able to claim the full amount on CBPS4's, but may have a limit imposed ( as with Adv Trg). As such cadets attending will have to make a contribution towards travel costs, which will be included in the amount charged for the weekend.

4. Even with this additional cost, the week should only cost the cadets **£50.00**.,Units are therefore requested to bid for cadet and staff places on the proforma attached. This should be returned to the undersigned by **7 JUNE 2008**, when selections and travel plans can be finalised. We do have another weekend at the end of the ½ term in October and this year bids for that camp will be at a date nearer to the event than previously.

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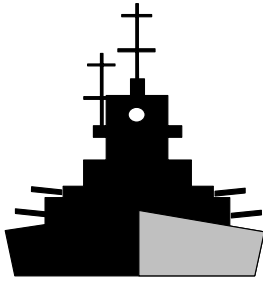

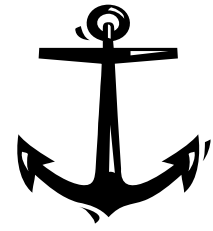
