HMS BRISTOL CAMPS 2011 + (RETURN DUE NOW FOR WEEK (AUGUST) CAMP)

1. I have now confirmed the 2 following weekends with CACTO Portsmouth for the stated number of cadets and staff. The bookings will be a normal weekend camp but are naturally subject to the ship having completed her refit (Latest is should be operational 3 May 11).

a. Fri 17 - Sun 19 June 2011 30m 10f cadets and up to 10 staff (which will include 2 CI's and at least 1 member of staff female) Travel will be by 4 Minibus's. Bids for staff and cadets will be issued in March - no action required at this stage. Costs are likely to be slightly higher than last year. Units are likely only to get 1 weekend allocation for the year.

b. Fri 28 - Sun 30 Oct 2011 30m 10f cadets and up to 10 staff (which will include 2 CI's and at least 1 member of staff female) Travel will be by 4 Minibus's. Bids for staff and cadets will be issued in March - no action required at this stage. Costs are likely to be slightly higher than last year. Units are likely only to get 1 weekend allocation for the year.

2. OC Wing has authorised a 6 day camp Sun - Fri in the summer holidays due to the 31% decrease in annual camp places for 2011. As such a 6 day camp has also been booked for the below dates and numbers, (and as such cadets who attend annual camp should not be nominated). The programme will hopefully include visits to Fleet Air Arm Museum (RNAS Yeovilton), Tank Museum at Bovington, New Forest 1 day walk, possibly a day visit (for some) to RAF Boscombe Down (Empire Test Pilots school) - and possible AEF opportunities, not yet confirmed, Hovercraft Trip to Rhyde (to be confirmed) and other Portsmouth based activities, which should include a Naval warship visit. All are subject to availability and the costs are likely to be the same as annual camps or maybe a little more expensive - possible £60.00.

Sun 14 Aug - Fri 19 Aug 2011 30m + 10 f cadets and up to 10 staff (which will include 2 CI's and at least 2 members of staff being female) Transport will be by 4 SOV's and bids for cadet and staff places are to be applied for on the attached proforma, and returned by **8 Feb 2011**. (same as annual camp returns) (max 6 Officers + 4 SNCO's/CI's).

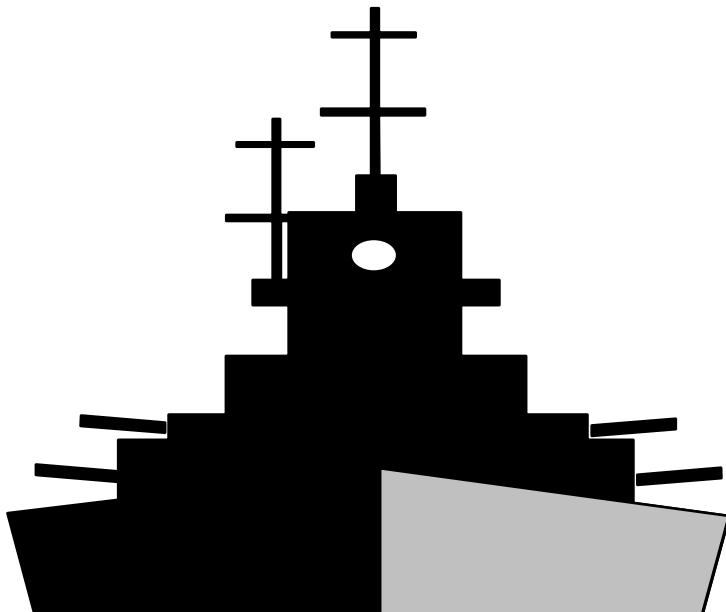
